Costs:

- **Show Fees:** For boarders - \$100/horse. (Includes assistance loading/unloading; horse hay, grain and water during show; trainer support and handling assistance at the show.)
- **Show Fees + Use of URC Horse:** \$150/horse. (Includes use of a URC horse up to a full day; assistance loading/unloading; horse hay, grain and water during show; trainer support and handling assistance at the show.)
 - **Show fee prices are for shows within 60 miles from the farm, with a minimum of 4 horses attending. Show fees will be increased if there are less than 4 people attending and/or the show is further than 60 miles away.**
- Overnight show costs will be the same as above per day at the show, plus food/lodging, shavings/tack room splits divided equally between participants. The cost of the weekly stall (approx. \$300/wk) is paid directly to the show along with the class entries.

Please note: Due to our limited space, **reservations to attend shows cannot be made without full payment.** Spaces are offered first come, first reserved with forms/payment! Always check with your instructor to make sure the show and your choice of horse is appropriate.

No refunds will be issued unless you find an alternate person to take your spot or a vet has declared your horse unfit to go, in which case the show fee will be held as credit to use another time.

Most shows require **pre-registration online.** Please confirm your show form/payment has been received and approved with Jessie BEFORE entering the show. You are responsible for registering by the closing date and confirming receipt.

Payment: The show date fee can be paid by Venmo, Cash or Check. The form itself can be emailed or placed in the green box. If paying by Venmo, the username is @Urbanaridingclub or it can be found under our business mobile number 240-877-4686.

Show Expectations

- o Thoroughly groom and/or bathe your horse, including their face- They should not have any visible dirt or stains on their body! Their mane and tail should be trimmed neat and tidy- please ask for permission Jessie before trimming a school horse's mane or tail!!
 - o If the horses are turned out the night before the show, plan to arrive extra early in the morning to catch and clean them.
- o Clean all tack and place it in the trailer tack room.
 - o Saddle pads should be freshly washed and not show signs of wear.
 - Fitted white saddle pads for hunters. Solid colors are acceptable in the jumpers only.
 - o Horses/pony's should be in leather bridles - please invest in your own tack if you are planning to show. Jessie can answer any questions you have.
- o Arrive to the barn a minimum of 45 minutes before the trailer is supposed to leave. If we are on night turn-out, expect to catch your horse in the morning if we are leaving prior to 8am.
- o Everyone going to the show is responsible for making sure we have enough hay bags packed and water jugs filled to last the horses all day- before we start to load the horses! The hay bags/water jugs are typically left in the trailer/tack room.
- o Show clothes should include:
 - o A solid-colored shirt with a collar- can be a polo or quarter-zip
 - o Tan breeches (with belt loops)
 - o A nice belt- typically leather black, brown, or dark blue
 - o Paddock boots and garter straps or tall boots (only required over 12)
 - o A crop (must be black if showing in a hunter division)
 - o Gloves (required for hunters, optional for jumpers).
 - o If competing in a hunter division, riders must be in a dark colored show coat (Black, Navy, Dark Green, Dark Brown) with a light-colored show shirt (white is typical, very light pastels/prints are accepted).
 - o For hunters, hair must be worn in braids with bows if under 12, or in a hairnet if over 12 years old.
 - o For jumpers, hair can be worn in a variety of styles: braids, ponytail, bun, hair net.
 - Wear your show clothes with something overtop to keep them clean until you are ready to show - ex. Sweatpants and a hoodie.
 - The best local tack stores for show clothes are The Surrey (good consignment selection to save \$\$), All About Equestrian (\$\$ but very knowledgeable), Stablemates Inc.
- o All attendees must stay for the full duration of the show to support their teammates and help take care of the horses- repacking hay bags, grazing, offering water, etc. In some cases, exceptions may be made for an additional horse care fee.
 - o Good sportsmanship toward the horses, teammates, and parents is expected at all times.
- o Parents should come to supervise and support their children. Occasionally students can ride in the trailer to/from the show with parent approval, but I only have 4 spaces and they are first come first serve by request.
- o Some shows do not have food/drinks for sale - please plan to bring food, drinks, chairs, sunscreen, etc. to comfortably survive the day. Expect to be there for the full day!
 - o Carpooling and potluck meals are encouraged
- o Once returning to the barn. All attendees are responsible for caring for their horse (washing, feed, turn-out, etc.), unpacking all tack/supplies, and mucking out the trailer space their horse used.
